DELEGATION

Walter Sawicki - City Storm Sewer Water

Mr. Sawicki advised that he lives 1.5 miles north of the intersection of McDonald Road and Broadway Avenue North, on the east side of the road. He explained that according to an agreement between the Ministry of Highways and the City of Melfort, the City is responsible for maintenance of the ditch from the north city limits to Melfort Creek, two miles north, the path of the city storm sewer water. The abandoned CPR rail bed is owned by the abutting property owners and water is running partly on highway property and part on private property. He circulated a drawing of the storm sewer water flow and reported that storm water runs over into his field, creating sloughs. The restrictions in the ditch cause water to back-up, creating problems down the line. The ditch is dry this year and he requested that culverts be cleaned out and sod removed on the inlet side. In closing, Mr. Sawicki suggested that a welcome sign be installed at the north end of the City. To Councillor Mitchell's question, Mr. Sawicki replied that he isn't aware of any neighbor complaints and there has only been a few instances where water has backed up and flooded the residents on the west side of the highway. Mayor Lang thanked Mr. Sawicki for his presentation and advised that the Works & Utilities Department will look into the matter and remedy the issue.
