### **DELEGATION**

### <u> Debbie Ferguson – Broadway Ave S Heavy Truck Route</u>

Ms. Ferguson referred to her letter dated December 31, 2020, expressing concerning about the heavy truck route on Broadway Avenue South, noting that there has been a steady increase in semi traffic since 2015 and she has counted up to 50 semis in a 12-hour period. Semis can access Highway 41 through Saskatchewan Drive and Highway 41A, so there is no negative effect to restricting weight on Broadway Avenue South. She also raised questions on Mr. Larson's behalf inquiring who is paying for the waterline replacement and paving on Broadway Avenue South and whether it would be cost-shared with the RMs or Ministry of Highways. There is no need for truck hauls south of Division Street, other than deliveries. Mr. Larson also questioned why the north walking trails were repaved prior to the first paving on the south side trails. A supporting letter from Cassandra Davis was also submitted. Council thanked Ms. Ferguson for her presentation and referred the issue to the Works & Utilities Committee.
