#### Access Communications - Mr. Martin Smith

Mr. Smith reported that effective August 17, 2020, the Access Communications office will be relocating to Darn Computers. He updated Council on Access's investment in their network across the province to expand internet services in 67 communities, including Melfort, to provide up to 300 mb/second by early September. This will allow Access Communications to launch next-generation products such as cloud-based video on demand. Mayor Lang thanked Mr. Smith for his presentation and commented that Access is a valuable addition to our community.

On behalf of MNP LLP, Mr. Jonathan Neigum presented the draft Audited Financial Statement to Council for the year ended December 31, 2019, reviewing the management responsibility letter and independent auditor's report.
