## DELEGATIONS

#### **North Central Health Foundation**

Mr. Garnet Davis, Chairman of the North Central Health Care Foundation, appeared before Council to report on the new \$510,000 fundraising campaign for the purchase of digital diagnostic imaging equipment to enhance existing x-ray services at the Melfort Hospital. He outlined the advantages of using the new technology and explained that the Foundation needs support from Melfort and the surrounding area to reach their target by the end of June.

#### SGEU – Liquor Store Privatization

Representing the SGEU, Ms. Echo Stringer expressed their concerns with the privatization of the Melfort liquor store and referred to the impact reports completed on the four closures in the past two years, and the projected loss of income to the government of approximately \$105 Million. She requested community support to keep the public liquor stores open. Council referred the issue to the Community Services Committee for review.
